

PGCA: A Cambridge qualification *in assessment*

Are you interested in studying assessment at Master's level? The *Postgraduate Advanced Certificate in Educational Studies: Educational Assessment* is a practice-based qualification designed to directly impact your work as you learn to apply various research methodologies to your professional context.
